HARFORD ARTS & HERITAGE JOBS GRANT PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION

WHAT: Public Information Session about the Hartford Arts & Heritage Jobs Grant Program

DETAILS:

- The City of Hartford and The Greater Hartford Arts Council are hosting an information session regarding the Hartford Arts & Heritage Jobs Grant Program proposed by Mayor Eddie A. Perez. This session will detail eligibility, timeline, grant conditions, and review criteria.
- The proposed program is designed to create and preserve jobs city-wide through more than \$1 million in funding for arts and heritage programming and projects. The program would be open to nonprofit organizations, artists, and projects based within the City of Hartford.
- Grants would be intended to help area arts organizations initiate new or expand current productions, exhibitions, events and youth employment programs, as well as improve facilities.
